Application Procedure for Service Academies though the Office of Congressman Carlos A. Gimenez

Note to Applicant: You are being considered for a nomination to one or more of the service academies. You will not be considered for an academy which you have not designated as your choice on the application form. However, you must meet the scores listed on the "Minimum Requirements" for the respective academy in order to be scheduled for an interview.

- **1. Application Form** Complete application form and attach a recent, high quality photograph
- **2. Recommendation Forms**—Ask your high school counselor or principal to complete one or someone who knows you well. Have them return the completed form to you in a sealed envelope with their signature across the seal
- **3.** Transcripts—Ask your counselor or principal for a copy of your transcripts and make sure the transcript includes your course listing and grades, current G.P.A., and class rank. The transcript should be returned to you in a sealed envelope with their signature across the seal.
- **4. Standardized Test Results**—Print and have scores delivered to our office either through in-person or through mail. Many transcripts will include copies of your SAT or ACT scores. If so, this is sufficient and you need not send in separate score results, unless you have updated scores. **No scores will be accepted after December 16**^{th.}
- **5. Deadline**—Send the above information to the South Florida Office. Completed application packets **must be received by December 16**th. The mailing address is: 14221 SW 120 th Street, Suite #115, Miami, FL 33186.
- **6. Interview** Interviews are held in **late December to early January**, at the South Florida Office. Qualified candidates will be contacted to schedule a fifteen minute interview. If you are unable to attend, you must send a written request for a waiver with your application packet. Waivers will be granted only to those who have military obligation or whose parents are stationed overseas on assignment.

Application Timeline

July 1 to November 1 — COMPLETE PACKET

Candidates must complete application packets and return them to Congressman Gimenez's South Florida Office.

December 16th — DEADLINE

All required information for a compelted application packet must be recieved by this date. Please make sure to use sufficent postage.

Late December to Early January — INTERVIEWS

Qualified candidates are interviewed for approximately 15 minutes by Congressman Gimenez's Service Academy Advisory Board. Interviews are held at the South Florida Office.

Early January — NOTIFICATION

Congressman Gimenez submits nominations to the academies and notifies all interviewed candidates of nomination status a few weeks after the interviews have taken place.

December – May

Although some appointments are offered beyond May, the academies will make the majority of appointments between December and May.

Late June or Early July

Appointed cadets are due at the U.S. service academies.

Minimum Requirements

Note to Applicant: The completion of these requirements makes one eligible but does not guarantee a nomination. Congressman Gimenez will submit the nominations to each academy, and selection is competitive. If you have not yet started a file at the academy of your choice, do so immediately.
