Dear Madam Secretary,

This letter is a follow-up to the March 19th, 2025 letter I wrote to you regarding the presence of agents of the murderous Castro regime and the Communist Party of Cuba currently residing in the United States. It is crucial that the Department of Homeland Security enforce existing U.S. laws to identify, deport, and repatriate these individuals who pose a threat to our national security.

I write to you today to request a status update on this initial request. We cannot allow those with direct connections to the Communist Party of Cuba to game our immigration laws, like the Cuban Adjustment Act, and enter our country. I am re-attaching the list of Cuban Nationals, with ties to the Castro regime currently living in the United States, who have been denounced by watchdog groups and independent non-profit organizations for perpetrating countless human rights abuses.

I request an update on the following:

1. Have any investigations begun on any person on this list?
2. Have any of these individuals been removed from the country?
3. If not, why haven't any of these individuals been investigated and will you commit to starting immediate investigations into these people of interest?

Please respond to my inquiry by September 26, 2025. Thank you for your continued support as House Republicans and the Trump Administration continue to work together to make America safer.
