I am requesting funding for the Sweetwater Housing Development Project in Fiscal Year 2025.

The entity to receive funding for this project is Miami Dade County Housing and Community Development located at 701 NW 1st Court, Miami, Florida 33136.

The funding would be used for the development of a 326 unit, mixed-age and mixed-income multifamily development. 40% of the units will be age restricted to individuals who are 55 years of age or older and designated as affordable housing. The remaining portion will be designated as workforce housing. This is a valuable use of taxpayer funds because access to housing is a real issue in Miami Dade County. This facility would provide housing to targeted low and moderate income communities dealing with lack of housing affordability and deterioration of housing integrity.

The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is consistent with purposes authorized in 42 U.S.C. 5305(a)(2).
